St. Joseph of Leonissa (1556-1612)

He preached to Christian slaves and offered himself in their place.

★**TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 5**

St. Agatha (231-251)

The young woman who died for her faith.

★**WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 6**

St. Paul Miki (d. 1597)

A Japanese Jesuit, and one of 26 Christians crucified by Japanese authorities.

★**THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 7**

Blessed Rosalie Rendu (1786-1856)

She and her Daughters of Charity served the poor of Paris and fostered discussions about how to change social problems.

★**FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 8**

St. Josephine Bakhita (1869-1947)

The Sudanese woman kidnapped and sold into slavery. She won her freedom, forgave her captors, and became a nun.

★**SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 9**

Blessed Jacoba of Settesoli

(1190-1273) The good friend of St. Francis who brought him his favorite cookies as he was dying.
